<b>NOTE: Service towards an Oceans or NC endorsement will be credited as follows:</b> 1. Service on GL will be credited day for day. 2. Service on inland waters, other than GL, may substitute for up to 50% of the total required service. 3. Service on vessels to which STCW applies (inland or NC) will be credited day for day.	11.401

<b>50 GRT</b> – 90 days (25%) required on vessels of 26 GRT or above, <b>OR</b> <b>180 days</b> (50%) required on vessels of 17 GRT or above  *** If the applicant has 1 day of service BEFORE March 24, 2014 on a vessel greater than 5 GRT, the MMC may be issued for 50 GRT without meeting this tonnage calculation.
