<b>HOLDS APPRENTICE MATE (STEERSMAN):</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
<b>WITH:</b> 1. 360 days on towing vessels as Apprentice Mate (Steersman) <b>AND</b> 2. 90 days must be on a particular route <b>AND</b> 3. TOAR <b>OR</b> approved course (No further exams required).	11.465	
<b>HOLDS MASTER TOWING VESSELS (LTD):</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
30 days of training & observation on towing vessels on a particular route; 90 days for Western Rivers <b>WITH</b> 1. Appropriate TOAR <b>OR</b> approved course <b>AND</b> 2. Pass an exam (unless AMS exam or courses previously completed).	11.465	
<b>HOLDS MATE STEAM/MOTOR &gt; 200 GRT OR FCP:</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
May operate towing vessels within any restrictions on their credential <b>AFTER</b> 1. 30 days of training & observation on towing vessels on a particular route; 90 days for Western Rivers <b>AND</b> 2. Either hold a completed TOAR or approved course <b>Note 1): Western Rivers requires 90 days of observation and training and Western Rivers must be endorsed on credential; EXCEPTION: if operating on LMR Pilotage waters, not required to hold WR endorsement but must hold Mate of T/V for other routes/waters.</b>	11.465       15.610	
<b>HOLDS MASTER STEAM/MOTOR VESSELS 200 GRT OR LESS (EXCEPT LIMITED MASTER):</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
1080 days service as Master under the authority of an endorsement <b>WITH</b> 1. 30 days of training & observation on towing vessels on a particular route; 90 days for Western Rivers <b>AND</b> 2. Appropriate TOAR, <b>AND</b> 3. Appropriate Apprentice Mate exams or courses covering exam required.	11.465	

<b>IF HOLDER OF MASTER TOWING VESSELS</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
The holder of an endorsement as master of towing vessels may have an endorsement placed on the MMC as mate (pilot) of towing vessels for a route superior to the current route on which the holder has no operating experience after passing an examination for that additional route. After holder completes 90 days of experience and a TOAR on that route, the MMC will be endorsed as Master of Towing and Mate (Pilot) will be removed.	11.464	
<b>Requirements for Adding A Route</b>		
<b>If holding an endorsement as Mate Greater Than 200 GRT:</b>  <b>Western Rivers</b> – 90 day of observation and training; AND WR TOAR; AND evidence of Apprentice Mate WR course/testing*. <b>Inland</b> – 30 days of observation and training; AND Inland TOAR; AND evidence of Apprentice Mate Inland course/testing*. <b>Near Coastal/Oceans</b> – 30 days of observation and training; AND NC/Oceans TOAR; AND evidence of Apprentice Mate NC/Oceans course/testing* <i>*only needs testing if adding a route not held on the inspected license</i>	11.465	
<b>If holding an endorsement as Mate T/V:</b> 90 days on requested route, appropriate TOAR and exam to add route
