720 days of service in the deck department on vessels operating in oceans, near coastal and Great Lakes waters , OF WHICH 1. Service on inland waters may substitute for up to 360 days of the required service; AND 2. 360 days of the required service must have been on vessels of more than 100 GRT OR	11.497

If service started prior to March 24, 2014 for Mate OSV 1600 GRT/3000 GT		
Option 1: Mariner must hold/qualify for a valid endorsement as Mate 500 OC/NC , he/she may have the MMC endorsed for service as Mate of OSVs 1600 GRT/3,000 GT (NC or Oceans as held with the inspected Mate 500). No additional training, assessment, or exams required.		
Option 2: Meet the requirements of Mate 500 OC/NC 720 days of deck service, OF WHICH: Service on Inland waters MAY substitute for up to 360 days of the required service, AND 360 days of service on vessels over 50 GRT AND Training: USCG approved Mate OSV Training and Assessment Program (OPTION 2 ONLY - training program may not cover exams.)
