360 days service in any capacity aboard a vessel that is required to hold regular fire and emergency and abandon ship drills as being relevant to the qualification of BT. Mariners may demonstrate that service on other vessels is relevant by providing evidence that their service included duties relevant to BT and/or that their service included ongoing participation in training and drills relevant to BT. Note: Service on vessels to which STCW applies such as Inspected vessels subject by regulation to conduct regular training is always accepted. Master / Mate 200 GRT NC - Renewal or RIG STCW 1. Basic Training or continuing competencies STCW will have corresponding 500 GT and NC limitation and <u>no</u> advanced fire fighting as capacity.	NVIC 02-14	
Master / Mate 200 GRT Ocean - Renewal or RIG STCW 1. Basic Training or continuing competencies 2. Advanced Fire Fighting with 5 years unless previously completed The STCW will have the corresponding 500 GT limitation and advanced fire fighting as a capacity.		
Master 100 GRT – Renewal or RIG STCW 1. Basic Training or continuing competencies The STCW will be limited to 100 GRT or 50 GRT/25 GRT as applicable.		
For original STCW, see the appropriate MMS Checklist. All above requirements to be valid after December 31, 2016 still apply to all.

2. Course approval will list task number, CFR cite and/or STCW regulation, any verbiage is acceptable.
3. Must be CG approved at time of completion, the provider must request retroactive approval from NMC-2.
4. A Leadership and Managerial Skills course used to meet operational (OICNW/EW) training requirements may be used again for management level STCW but must have been completed with the previous 5 years per NVIC 03-14.

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
