Provide completion of CG Approved <i>Tank Ship Dangerous Liquids</i> Course <b>AND</b></li> <li>b. Provide evidence of either: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i. 90 days of service as an engineering officer on oil tankers <b>OR</b></li> <li>ii. 90 days of rating or cadet service on deck or in the engine department on oil tankers <b>OR</b></li> <li>iii. <b>Cross-Over</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
A mariner holding an endorsement in <b>Advanced Chemical Tanker Cargo Operations</b> or <b>Advanced Liquefied Gas Tanker Cargo Operations</b> may obtain an endorsement for <b>Advanced Oil Tanker Cargo Operations</b> by completing, in a supernumery capacity, an approved training program onboard oil tankers (the program must be at least 1 month and include at least 3 loadings and 3 discharges).	13.603	
<b>Grandfathering – Issued prior to March 24, 2014</b>	<b>46 CFR</b>	
<p>Mariners holding valid Tankerman-PIC DL, Tankerman-PIC (Barge) DL, or Tankerman-Engineer endorsements may be issued STCW endorsements for Advanced Oil <b>OR</b> Chemical Tanker Cargo Operations, as appropriate, without having to meet additional requirements.</p> <p>Mariners holding a national endorsement as Tankerman-PIC (Barge) DL will be limited to non-self-propelled vessels.</p> <p>Mariners holding a national endorsement as Tankerman-Engineer will be limited to maintenance and repair of cargo equipment.</p>	13.603 NVIC 02-14	
<b>Grandfathering – Service or Training prior to March 24, 2014</b>		
<p>For national endorsements as Tankerman-PIC DL, Tankerman-PIC (Barge) DL, or Tankerman-Engineer may be issued STCW endorsements for Advanced Oil <b>AND</b> Chemical Tanker Cargo Operations without having to meet additional requirements until December 31, 2016.</p> <p>Mariners holding national endorsements as Tankerman-PIC (Barge) DL or Tankerman-Engineer will be limited same as above.</p>	NVIC 02-14
