

Tips:



As of April 15, 2009 mariners must show proof to the CG-Regional Examination Center (REC) of having applied for or having been issued a Transportation Worker's Identification Credential (TWIC) from the Transportation Security Administration (TSA). One of the many advantages of this change is that mariners are no longer required to visit a CG-REC in person and can submit new applications or resolve deficiencies electronically or by mail. Also, original documentation is no longer required! Copies of your application and all associated attachments are now acceptable.
