



Captain June E. Ryan

Captain Ryan serves as the Pacific Area Chief of Staff in Alameda, California. Prior to reporting to Pacific Area, she served as Deputy, Director of Response Policy (CG-53d) overseeing the development of strategic doctrine and policy guidance for Coast Guard forces. These policies encompass operational maritime missions in the areas of law enforcement, search and rescue, marine environmental response, counterterrorism and defense operations, incident management, and preparedness, and contingency exercise programs.

Captain Ryan enlisted in the Coast Guard Reserves in 1982 and attained the rate of Boatswain's Mate Third Class. After graduating from Officer Candidate School, she served aboard cutter GALLATIN. Captain Ryan's afloat commands included cutters CAPE MORGAN and NEAH BAY. Her ashore commands include Commander, Group Charleston, South Carolina; and Commander, Sector North Carolina where she served simultaneously as the Captain of the Port, Federal Maritime Security Coordinator, and Federal On-Scene Coordinator for oil and hazardous materials releases in the coastal zone. Other command cadre assignments include Deputy Group Commander, St. Petersburg, Florida and Deputy Sector Commander/Alternate Captain of the Port in Charleston, South Carolina.



Captain Ryan's staff assignments include Executive Assistant to the Coast Guard Pacific Area Commander, Senior Instructor, Maritime Law Enforcement School and three tours in Coast Guard Headquarters, Washington, DC. Captain Ryan served as the Military Aide to the President, the third woman in U.S. history to do so. She represented the United States of America during many high profile White House events and various International Summits and Head of State meetings.

Captain Ryan is a native of Bettendorf, Iowa. She holds a Bachelors of Science degree in Biology from Bowling Green State University and a Master of Arts degree in Adult Education from University of South Florida.

Captain Ryan's personal awards include the Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit, six Coast Guard Meritorious Service Medals, two Coast Guard Commendation Medals, two Achievement Medals. She wears the Presidential Service Badge as well as the Boat Force Operations and Cutterman pin.

Captain Ryan, formerly June McIntee, is married to CWO Timothy P. Ryan, USCG, Retired, of Wayne, New Jersey. They currently reside in Alameda with their 10 year old daughter.
