His previous role was as the Director of the FORCECOM Implementation Team. FC-5 is responsible for the Coast Guard's training system, doctrine development, and exercise support. All CG training centers and training support units work within FC-5.



Captain Marvin recently served a four-year Command assignment at Training Center Petaluma where his crews trained 18,000 sailors, improved facilities and won numerous national and international awards. He has both afloat and ashore experience during his Coast Guard career. He served as Commanding Officer of the sea-going buoy tender COWSLIP in Astoria OR, and earlier tours aboard HORNBEAM in Cape May NJ and CITRUS in Coos Bay OR. His shore assignments include the Pay & Personnel Center in Topeka KS, the Coast Guard Academy in New London CT, and the Fifth Coast Guard District in Portsmouth VA.

He is a graduate of the U. S. Coast Guard Academy with a BS in Ocean Engineering, and later earned a Masters Degree in Training & Education Systems at Indiana University. He is a member of the International Society for Performance Improvement.
