



# Commander Sean P. Ryan

Commander **Sean P. Ryan** is the staff champion for FORCECOM's Intelligence Division (FC-2). Currently, he serves as the division chief of intelligence for the Pacific Area, having been detailed July 1, 2009. He will become the division chief of FC-2 once Congressional Authorization is received and the 3-Star Force Readiness Command is stood up. FC-2 will develop and provide intelligence collection and dissemination doctrine, and will also support current and future mission requirements.

Commander Ryan has had two previous intelligence tours: first, as an analyst on the Pacific Area Intelligence staff and more recently as the Maritime Intelligence Fusion Center Pacific's Watch Chief. Commander Ryan has gathered substantial operations experience in cutter operations, as a Deck Watch Officer on CGC MUNRO; deployable operations, as the Logistics Officer of Port Security Unit 313, and in shore based boat forces, as Sector San Francisco's Enforcement Division Chief where he was responsible for coordinating the operations of seven small boat stations and four patrol boats in his most recent assignment.

The U. S. Coast Guard Academy graduate is completing work for a Masters in Organizational Leadership from Chapman University.
