SUBJ: EMT REREGISTRATION: NATIONAL REGISTRY OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL
TECHNICIANS (NREMT)

1. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MESSAGE IS TO REMIND COAST GUARD MEMBERS WHO
ARE REGISTERED AS AN EMT-BASIC THROUGH NREMT THAT REGISTRATIONS
LAPSE ON MARCH 31ST OF THE 2ND YEAR AFTER THE INITIAL REGISTRATION.
WAIVERS ARE NORMALLY NOT GRANTED BY NREMT. REQUESTS FOR
REREGISTRATION MUST BE SUBMITTED THROUGH THE LOCAL CHAIN OF COMMAND
TO: COMMANDANT (CG-1121) U.S. COAST GUARD, 2100 2ND STREET SW,
WASHINGTON DC, 20593-0001 ATTN: HS1 JASON CARLISLE. ALLOW ENOUGH
TIME (SUGGEST MINIMUM 14 DAYS) FOR PACKAGES TO ARRIVE AT COAST
GUARD HEADQUARTERS, BE PROCESSED, AND SENT TO NREMT. ALL
REREGISTRATION PACKAGES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY MARCH 31ST.

2. REREGISTRATION REQUESTS MUST INCLUDE THE NREMT REGISTRATION
FORM AND ONE COPY OF THE FOLLOWING: CERTIFICATE OF REFRESHER COURSE
COMPLETION, CURRENT CARDIO-PULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR)/AUTOMATED
EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR (AED) FOR THE PROFESSIONAL RESCUER
CERTIFICATION, AND A RECORD OF 72 HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION.
MAINTAINING CURRENT EMT-B CERTIFICATION IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF
THE MEMBER.

3. IF A MEMBER ALLOWS THEIR REGISTRATION TO LAPSE, THEY MAY STILL
BE ELIGIBLE FOR REINSTATEMENT IF CERTAIN CRITERIA ARE MET. TO BE
CONSIDERED FOR REINSTATEMENT, MEMBERS MUST BE WITHIN A TWO YEAR
PERIOD OF THEIR REGISTRATION LAPSING, HAVE COMPLETED A RECENT
RECERTIFICATION COURSE, CURRENT CPR/AED FOR PROFESSIONAL RESCUER
CERTIFICATION, AND PASS THE WRITTEN EXAM AND PRACTICAL SKILLS
VERIFICATION. NORMALLY, STUDENTS ATTEND A RECERTIFICATION COURSE AT
TRACEN PETALUMA AND UPON COMPLETION, STUDENTS WILL HAVE AN
OPPORTUNITY TO TEST WHILE AT THE TRAINING CENTER. IF THE STUDENT
FAILS THE COURSE, THEY MUST RETURN TO THEIR COMMAND AND REQUEST AN
NREMT EXAMINATION THROUGH THEIR UNIT EDUCATION SERVICES OFFICER
(ESO) VIA COMDT CG-1121.

4. IF THE LAPSED CERTIFICATION EXCEEDS A TWO YEAR PERIOD, A
COMPLETE EMT-BASIC COURSE MUST BE COMPLETED FOR REGISTRATION TO BE
PROCESSED.

5. THE NATIONAL REGISTRY HAS INSTITUTED A FIFTY DOLLAR LATE FEE IF

PACKAGES ARE NOT POSTMARKED BEFORE THE MARCH 31ST DEADLINE.
COMMANDANT (CG-1121) WILL PAY THE REREGISTRATION FEE, BUT NOT THE
LATE FEE (EXCEPT IN CASES WHERE IT IS CLEAR THAT THE CIRCUMSTANCES
WERE BEYOND THE MEMBERS CONTROL).
