SUBSEQUENT ASSIGNMENT TO A DIVING DUTY POSITION: EAST AND WEST COAST
DIVE LOCKERS, NAVAL DIVING AND SALVAGE TRAINING CENTER
(NDSTC) OR THE RATED COLLATERAL DUTY DIVERS ON BOARD D14 225'S.

MEMBERS TOUR COMPLETE IN AY11 WISHING TO COMPETE FOR VACANT POSITIONS
MUST FOLLOW THE APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOUND IN REFS B AND C. ALL
APPLICATIONS ARE DUE TO NDSTC AND ALL COMMAND ENDORSED E-RESUMES ARE
DUE NO LATER THAN 9APR 2010. THOSE ABOVE AN ADVANCEMENT CUT OR ON THE
SUPPLEMENTAL LIST FOR ADVANCEMENT SHOULD COMPETE FOR POSITIONS IN THE

5. PT REQUIREMENTS: THE PHYSICAL SCREENING REQUIREMENTS ARE SET BY THE NAVY AND ARE THE SAME FOR ALL MEMBERS REGARDLESS OF GENDER OR AGE. THE SCREENING TEST IS OUTLINED IN FURTHER DETAIL IN APPENDIX E OF REF B AND CONSISTS OF A 500YD SWIM USING SIDE OR BREAST STROKE IN LESS THAN 14 MINS FOLLOWED BY A 10 MIN REST. MINIMUM OF 42 PUSH-UPS IN 2 MINS FOLLOWED BY A 2 MIN REST. MINIMUM OF 50 SIT-UPS IN 2 MINS FOLLOWED BY A 2 MIN REST. MINIMUM OF 6 PULL-UPS FOLLOWED BY A 10 MIN REST. FINISHING WITH A MILE AND A HALF RUN IN UNDER 12 MINS

45 SECS. CANDIDATES SHOULD NOT SEEK A COMMAND ENDORSEMENT OR DIVING PHYSICAL EXAMINATION UNTIL ABLE TO PASS THE PHYSICAL SCREENING TEST.

6. DIVER CANDIDATE SCREENING AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS ARE LOCATED WITHIN REFERENCE (B). ADDITIONALLY, A THREE WEEK PRESCREENING TRAINING SESSION WILL BE HOSTED BY THE DIVE PROGRAM ON OR ABOUT 17MAY 2010 AT A LOCATION TO BE DETERMINED. THE TRAINING WILL INCLUDE CLASSROOM AND PHYSICAL TRAINING SIMILAR TO THE ACTUAL DIVE TRAINING AT NDSTC. ALL CANDIDATES NOT PREVIOUSLY QUALIFIED AS SECOND CLASS DIVERS MUST ATTEND FOR CONSIDERATION. ALL TAD EXPENSES WILL BE FUNDED BY THE DIVE PROGRAM.

7. MEMBERS WITH PREVIOUS DIVE TRAINING ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO APPLY HOWEVER ALL MEMBERS WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR THESE POSITIONS WHILE BALANCING THE NEEDS OF THE SERVICE, UNIT AND MEMBER WHILE UTILIZING ALL ASSIGNMENT FACTORS.

8. ALL CANDIDATES (WHETHER PREVIOUSLY QUALIFIED SECOND CLASS DIVERS OR NOT):

A. MUST COMPLETE THE OVERSEAS SCREENING PROCESS MEETING ALL OVERSEAS DUTY CRITERIA LISTED IN REFERENCE A. THE COMPLETED OVERSEAS SCREENING CHECKLIST MUST BE INCLUDED IN YOUR APPLICATION.

THOSE MEMBERS WITHOUT THE OVERSEAS SCREENING COMPLETED WILL NOT BE SELECTED FOR THESE ASSIGNMENTS. A COPY OF THE COMPLETED OVERSEAS SCREENING CHECKLIST MUST BE SENT VIA EMAIL TO LT BLAIR, INFO LISTED BELOW.
