

IT PROVIDES A SUMMARY LIST OF COAST GUARD REQUIREMENTS TO EXAMINERS AND OWNER/OPERATORS OF UNINSPECTED PASSENGER VESSELS OF LESS THAN 100 GROSS TONS AND CARRYING SIX OR LESS PASSENGERS. THIS BOOKLET SHOULD BE USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE REGULATIONS ALONG WITH OTHER AIDS DEVELOPED BY THE COAST GUARD TO ASSIST IN UNDERSTANDING THE REGULATIONS.
