

Sector/PSU Command Master Chief (CMC), Senior Chief (CSC), Command Chief (CC) Silver Badge Panel

Overview. Command Master Chiefs (CMCs) represent their commander, communicating the commander's goals and direction for the command to the field, while simultaneously representing the field's views and concerns to the commander. CMCs offer a field reality check as they provide input to high level policy makers. They also act as the resource person, assisting CG personnel and subordinate commands as required. Although CMCs are not in the chain of command, they strengthen it by working within the chain of command whenever possible to provide ground-truth feedback. They enhance communication and foster a better understanding of the needs and viewpoints of all member of the CG family. For a complete job description please read COMDTINST 1306.1 (series).

Minimum Qualifications:

- You must be an E-7, E-8 or E-9
- Applicants must have the CPO Academy or DOD Senior NCO Course completed on the date of application; **the Keystone course is not a substitution**
- You **MUST** meet the Special Assignments criteria outlined in the PERSMAN, [Arts. 4.E.2.A](#) and the Command Senior Enlisted Leadership Program, [COMDTINST 1306.1 \(series\)](#)

- Essay Topic:
"The leadership role of SELRES Command Senior Enlisted Leaders"

- Biographical Information – Resume should be a professional style resume not to exceed one page. It should cover your past three assignments or career history from CPO and above. At a minimum, your resume should include past assignments, duties and collaterals, prior training and education, and personal awards and recognitions. Please ensure under education you list the date(s) and location(s) of attendance at a Senior Leadership Academy (e.g. CPO Academy, U.S. Sargents Major Academy, U.S. Air Force NCO-Academy).
- Photos as prescribed in COMDTINST 1306.1 (series)
- Credit Check Authorization DHS Form 11000-9. **Please hand-write your home address on the bottom of this form.**
- Authorization for Release of Information, SF-86-1. **Please hand-write your drivers' license number and state of issuance on the bottom of this form.**
- Member counseling report as prescribed in COMDTINST 1306.1 (series)

Command Endorsement:

“Member meets the minimum requirements outlined in PERSMAN Arts. 4.E.2.A, 4.E.12, and COMDTINST 1306.1 (series). Package under separate cover.” If applicable “member prescreened and meets minimum requirements for Overseas Assignment.”

Tour Lengths:

New assignments will be three years.

Competition:

“What is Best Qualified?” Selections are made on the basis of best qualified from ALL ratings. Competitive applicants have the highest moral and ethical standards, demonstrated leadership roles, embody the Coast Guard core values, exhibit exemplary grooming and fitness, as well as maturity, even temperament and outstanding judgment. An applicant must have excellent “people” and public speaking skills.

TIS (Time In Service) Waivers :

Members must have LESS than 28 years of service on the date of assignment to a CMC/CSC/CC position using the 1 June 2011 as the constructive date. TIS waiver may be considered depending on service needs. Waiver MUST be addressed on a separate memorandum with command endorsement. Waivers should include current time in service (pay base date).

Pay and Allowances:

SDAP 1 - \$75.00 (Prorated based upon the type of active duty or inactive duty performed)

Training:

At the earliest opportunity, member shall attend the Keystone Course located in New London, CT
