

**LIEUTENANT JACOB T. McMILLAN**  
**COMMANDING OFFICER**  
**USCGC FARALLON (WPB 1301)**

Lieutenant Jacob McMillan is a native of Valdosta, GA and graduated from the University of Georgia in 2001 with a Bachelor of Arts in History. In 2005, LT McMillan attended Officer Candidate School in New London, CT. After graduating in May 2005, LT McMillan reported to the District Eight Command Center in New Orleans, LA. In August 2005, three days before Hurricane Katrina made landfall, LT McMillan was reassigned as a Coast Guard Liaison Officer to the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency, where he participated in the Coast Guard's historic hurricane response. From 2006-2007, LT McMillan served in the District Eight Aids to Navigation branch and rebuilt critical navigation aids following the 2005 hurricane season.

In 2007, LT McMillan reported to USCGC CONFIDENCE, homeported in Cape Canaveral, FL, and served as a Deck Watch Officer during ten maritime law enforcement patrols. After completing his tour onboard CONFIDENCE, LT McMillan reported to USCGC VALIANT, homeported in Miami, FL, to serve as the Operations Officer. From 2009-2011, VALIANT conducted ten successful law enforcement patrols, interdicting over five tons of cocaine and rescuing over 300 migrants at sea. In addition, in January 2010, VALIANT was one of the first Coast Guard assets to respond to the devastating earthquake in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. VALIANT conducted critical Haitian port assessments along Haiti's north coast and also provided a vital communication and helicopter operations platform.

LT McMillan's personal awards include the Coast Guard Commendation Medal, the Coast Guard Achievement Medal, and the Commandant's Letter of Commendation.
