QTY	Equipment List
1	Soft body armor (level IIIA) with level IV plates (It is recommended that the students get used to wearing the full kit before arriving to the course. Students can expect to wear the kit for 12 hours a day IAW DOGINST 4130.2.)
1	Ballistic helmet (Level IIIA) (Helmet must have clear identifying NIJ rated protection level on the helmet, or unit shall provide documentation stating level of protection IAW DOGINST 4130.2)
1	Individual first aid kit (IAW Tactical Medical Manual, COMDTINST M16601.16 series)
1	M40A1 Protective Field Mask (Gas Mask) with Carrier -Carrier -Eyeglass inserts if required
1	Sleeping Bag
1	Triple Mag Pouch (5.56)
1	Butt Pack (Optional)

QTY	Individual Equipment
1	Boots
2	Desert Camouflage Uniform (DCU) or Navy Working Uniform, if issued. The minimum number of sets required is 3.
2	Utility Uniform Cover
1	Foul weather gear – Top and bottom (Cold, rain, etc) – See *Note 3
1	Personal hygiene items (Shower shoes, towels, etc) to include foot powder
1	PT uniforms (IAW ALCOAST 278/09 Required PT Uniform) – See *Note 3
1	Running Shoes
1	Appropriate Civilian Attire (see SMTC website for more information)
1	Combination lock
1	Medical alert tags/bracelet (As required)
2	Eyeglasses w/ prescription pro-mask insert as required
1	Seabag or flight bag that can be locked with a padlock
6	Undergarments for 6 days (minimum)
1	Gloves with inserts
1	Baby Wipes (Optional)
1	Insulated boots during winter months (Optional)
1	Multi-Utility Tool (Ex: Gerber, Leatherman, etc) (Optional)
1	Poncho and Poncho Liner (Optional)
1	Watch Cap (Optional)

1	Blue Sweatshirt (Plain or USCG, No hood Preferred) (Optional)

QTY	Individual Documentation
1	Military identification card
1	Complete medical questionnaire
1	Copy of DD-2766 adult preventive/chronic care flowsheet and actual medical records
1	Current CG-3029s for M16.
1	CG-3029s for PQS on the M16. PQS shall be completed within <u>90 days</u> of report date. (PQS will be confirmed upon arrival to SMTC and failure may <u>result in disenrollment</u>).
1	Memo from parent command stating student successfully completed the GO/NO GO Tier 2 Physical Fitness Test per deployable operations group Physical Fitness Program, DOGINST 6110.1, within 180 days of convening class date.

* Note 1: Unit specific t-shirts, ball caps or wickable clothing is not authorized with USCG uniform. All CCU/DCU must be in accordance with DOGINST 1020.1B. Unit and individual patches must be removed prior to reporting to SMTC.

** Note 2: Quota cancellations/changes/messages – parent commands shall send student cancellation/changes messages to SMTC, TQC and DOG prior to convening to provide time to reissue orders. No substitutions will be accepted if official message has not been received and may result in members being disenrolled.
