Dragos Rauta is the Technical Director of the International Association of Independent Tanker Owners (INTERTANKO). He is also Chairman of the Advisory Committee to the IACS Quality System Certification Scheme (QSCS) and a member of Det Norske Veritas Nordic Committee for Safety at Sea.

Mr. Rauta was trained as a Naval Architect and Mechanical Engineer in Romania (the country where he was born) and Norway (his adoptive country since 1989). His activity prior to INTERTANKO included ship construction, ship design and ship research in towing tank facilities. He was a member of the US National Research Council/Marine Board Committee on Evaluating Alternative Tanker Designs and a member of various SNAME Panels on tanker stability, environmental performance, and structural design..

He joined INTERTANKO in September 1990, just one month after the enactment of the US Oil Pollution Act of 1990, overseeing all technical & engineering activities within INTERTANKO. In 2002 Mr. Rauta set up the INTERTANKO US Office in Arlington, VA which he ran until 2005. He is currently responsible for coordinating the INTERTANKO Oslo Office activities. He also represents INTERTANKO at the International Maritime Organization's relevant Committees and Sub-Committees.
