Paul Topping is Manager, Environmental Protection, with Marine Safety at Transport Canada's Headquarters in Ottawa. He joined Transport Canada in November 2007 and manages a regulatory program dealing with environmental issues facing marine shipping, including preventing pollution, reducing greenhouse gases, managing ballast water, and recycling of old ships.

Mr. Topping holds a degree in honours biology from the University of Waterloo. He has held positions at Environment Canada for 18 years on waste management and marine environmental protection issues, often working with the marine industry, Transport Canada, other departments and international organizations. A long-serving Canadian delegate to the International Maritime Organization (IMO) Marine Environmental Protection Committee, he currently chairs IMO's Review of MARPOL Annex V and represents Canada in discussions on IMO's emerging greenhouse gas framework and the new Convention on ship recycling.
