

## M870 Shotgun PQS Checklist.

1. RECITE the four weapons safety rules.
2. IDENTIFY the different types of ammunition used in the M870 Police Shotgun and their characteristics:
  - Dummy
  - 00 Buck
  - Lead Slug
  - Copper Slug
  - Frangible
  - Less than Lethal
3. DEMONSTRATE procedures for verifying that the M870 Police Shotgun is clear and safe.
4. IDENTIFY the M870 Police Shotgun's safety and the effect of it on the weapon.
5. DESCRIBE the following sights utilized on the M870 Police Shotgun:
  - Front Sight
  - Rear Sight
  - ACOG Sight
6. DEMONSTRATE loading procedures for the M870 Police Shotgun. (Using Dummy Rounds only)
7. DESCRIBE the standard method of carry for the M870 Police Shotgun.
8. DEMONSTRATE the procedures for firing the M870 Police Shotgun from the loaded magazine/empty chamber condition.
9. DEMONSTRATE un-loading procedures for the M870 Police Shotgun from a loaded chamber condition. (Using Dummy Rounds only)
10. DEMONSTRATE un-loading procedures for the M870 Police Shotgun from the empty chamber condition. (Using Dummy Rounds only)
11. DEMONSTRATE the procedures for ensuring the M870 Police Shotgun is un-loaded, clear, and safe.
12. DEMONSTRATE emergency procedures for the M870 Police Shotgun.
  - Misfire
  - Double Feed
  - Stove Pipe (failure to eject)
  - Action unable to unlock and chamber a round
13. FIELD STRIP the M870 Police Shotgun and IDENTIFY the following assemblies and components:
  - Trigger Assembly
    - Safety
    - Action Bar Lock
    - Carrier
  - Barrel Assembly
    - Front Sight
  - Fore End Assembly
  - Receiver Assembly
    - Shell Latches
    - Magazine Tube
    - Magazine Cap
    - Ejection Port
    - Loading Port
    - Rear Sight
  - Bolt and Bolt Carrier Assembly
  - ACOG Sight Assembly
14. DEMONSTRATE re-assembly procedures for the M870 Police Shotgun.
15. DEMONSTRATE the M870 Police Shotgun safety and function check.
