If you withdrew from the course(s) due to a change in military duty or assignment, emergency leave, unexpected PCS or TAD orders, or illness and/or hospitalization and you received a grade of "W", provide a letter from your Commanding Officer stating the reason. Reimbursement can be waived for "W" grades only.
4. Attach your response to this letter and return to NETPDTC, Code N8132, 6490 Saufley Field Road, Pensacola, FL 32509-5241.
5. Money orders should be made payable to the Treasurer of the United States. Include your SSN, Tuition Assistance document number and course number with your response.
6. Request you respond within 30 days of the date of this letter. Failure to resolve this issue promptly will result in involuntary pay checkage. Your due process rights are described in reference (c).
