- 1. Cover Letter
- 2. Resume displaying:
 - Experience in sound reinforcement, recording, and editing.
 - Musical training and/or instruments played.
 - Administrative experience
 - Education
 - Three professional references
- 3. Demo recordings highlighting your work with the various styles listed below. Please also include a written description of the situation, equipment, and microphone technique used for each selection. If possible, include:
 - Large Ensemble: Orchestra, Concert Band
 - Chamber Group: Woodwind Quintet, Brass Quintet, String Quartet
 - Choral Group: with or without instrumentalists
 - Jazz or Pop
 - Vocal soloist with any of the above groups.

Qualifying candidates will be contacted to schedule a remote prescreen interview.

Highly qualified candidates will be invited to a live audition on **February 5th or 6th, 2024**. (The Coast Guard Band may be able to accommodate significant schedule conflicts). The live audition will involve a 90-minute time slot with the U.S. Coast Guard Traditional Jazz Band.
