NOTE: Due to obligations to the Military District of Washington and Arlington National Cemetery, all requests, even after approval, are subject to cancellation at any time. We appreciate your understanding and flexibility.

Per Honor Guard SOP, the Honor Guard will only support retirement requests for 0-5 and above, CWO4, Master Chiefs, and members with 30 plus years of service. Waivers must be routed through the Honor Guard Commanding Officer.

- † The ideal minimum height requirements are 17' for Color Guard and 20' for Drill Team. The Drill Team also has an ideal spacing requirement of 35'x35' for the full team and 15'x15' for the Center Four performance. In all cases, however, the Honor Guard is flexible and is willing to make exceptions as necessary.
- *The Honor Guard requests that funding be provided for all missions at a distance of 75 miles or greater from Coast Guard Honor Guard (Alexandria, VA). If funding is unavailable, the approval of the request will be left to the discretion of the Honor Guard CO.
- ** This request must be received no later than 05 days prior to the event date.
