CONSENT ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

On September 11, 2023, the parties in this case submitted a Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order (Settlement Agreement) to be approved as a settlement of the case under 33 C.F.R. § 20.502, that included drafting errors.

During a telephonic prehearing conference held on October 24, 2023, the Coast Guard clarified that the Settlement Agreement in this matter was intended to have Respondent meet with a Substance Abuse Professional (SAP), fulfill the treatment plan the SAP mandated, do this in conjunction with a six-month outright suspension, followed by a period of probation. Due to drafting errors, the September 11, 2023 Settlement Agreement does not provide this.

The Coast Guard submitted a revised Settlement Agreement on November 8, 2023. I have carefully reviewed the terms of the revised Settlement Agreement and find it is fair and reasonable and in substantial compliance with the requirements of 33 C.F.R. § 20.502.

ORDER

Upon consideration of the record, it is hereby **ORDERED**, the revised Settlement Agreement is **APPROVED** in full and incorporated herein by reference. This Consent Order shall constitute full, final, and complete adjudication of this proceeding.
