ORDER OF ADMISSION

On June 27, 2023, the United States Coast Guard (Coast Guard) issued a Complaint against Carrie Virginia Alvarado (Respondent) alleging misconduct pursuant to 46 U.S.C. § 7703(1)(B). The Coast Guard proposed a sanction of three (3) months outright suspension.

The ALJ Docketing Center received Respondent's Answer, dated August 9, 2023, admitting all jurisdictional and factual allegations and agreeing to the proposed sanction.

WHEREFORE,

Based on consideration of the record, I hereby **ORDER** that the allegations in the Complaint are **PROVED BY ANSWER**. I have carefully reviewed the Complaint and Answer and find that the proposed sanction is appropriate under the provisions of 46 C.F.R. § 5.569.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent's Coast Guard issued Merchant Mariner Credentials are Suspended Outright for three (3) Months, commencing on the date Respondent's credentials are deposited with the USCG San Francisco. Respondent shall immediately deposit, by mail or in person, her Merchant Mariner Credential and any other Coast Guard issued

credentials to: USCG Sector San Francisco, 1 Yerba Buena Rd., Bldg. 26, San Francisco, CA 94130. Further, Respondent shall immediately cease using all Coast Guard issued credentials, including his Merchant Mariner Credential.
