ORDER MEMORIALIZING PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE & CONSENT ORDER APPROVING AMENDED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

On October 19, 2023, I convened a pre-hearing telephone conference to discuss the United States Coast Guard's (Coast Guard) Motion for Approval of a Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order. 33 C.F.R. § 20.501. Daniel B. Schaefer, Esq., and LT Hayden L. Veech appeared on behalf of the Coast Guard and Craig Sinclair Como (Respondent) appeared on his own behalf, *pro se*.

At the outset of the conference, I inquired whether Respondent had retained an attorney or representative in this matter and Respondent stated he would proceed without counsel. I also advised the parties of my role as an independent fact finder and explained my decisions and rulings are not graded nor scored by the Coast Guard and I am not subject to performance evaluations. 33 C.F.R. § 20.206.

After some discussion and review of the Coast Guard's Motion, I explained to the parties that the signatures accompanying the agreement lacked a date. Furthermore, because the agreement specifically referenced the signature date, I noted those references would be unenforceable. To correct the issue, I suggested the parties file a motion to amend the agreement

along with an affidavit indicating the date the original document was signed.

On October 23, 2023, the Coast Guard filed a Joint Motion for Amendment of

Settlement Agreement and a supporting affidavit. Upon review of the file and after being

sufficiently advised I find the Amended Settlement Agreement is fair, reasonable, and in

substantial compliance with the requirements of 33 C.F.R. § 20.502. Accordingly, the Coast

Guard's Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement and Joint Motion for Amendment of

Settlement Agreement are **GRANTED**. The Amended Settlement Agreement is **APPROVED**

in full and incorporated herein by reference. This Consent Order shall constitute full, final, and

complete adjudication of this proceeding.
