#### CONSENT ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The United States Coast Guard (Coast Guard) served Jaunte Emmit Wade (Respondent) with a Complaint on April 15, 2024. On June 6, 2024, the Coast Guard filed a Motion for Default Order due to Respondent's failure to submit a timely Answer, as defined by 33 CFR § 20.308(a). Conversely, the parties filed a Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order, on June 13, 2024, requesting approval of the Settlement Agreement under 33 C.F.R. § 20.502. Since the Coast Guard entered into a Settlement Agreement with the Respondent, it filed a Motion for Withdraw of Motion for Default, on June 13, 2024, thereby requesting withdrawal of the Motion for Default Order.

I have carefully reviewed the terms of the Settlement Agreement and find it is fair and reasonable and in substantial compliance with the requirements of 33 C.F.R. § 20.502. As such, it should not be prevented. <u>Appeal Decision 2623 (LOVE)</u> (2001).

Upon consideration of the record, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Coast Guard's Motion for Withdraw of Motion for Default is DENIED as moot.
- The stipulated Settlement Agreement is APPROVED in full and incorporated herein by reference. This Consent Order shall constitute full, final, and complete adjudication of this proceeding.
