ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR WITHDRAWAL AND CANCELLING HEARING

On October 8, 2024, the Coast Guard submitted a Motion for Withdraw[al] (Motion), requesting the above-captioned case be dismissed without prejudice because Respondent voluntarily surrendered his Merchant Mariner Credential (credential) pursuant to 46 C.F.R. § 5.203. The Coast Guard attached to the Motion a Voluntary Surrender Agreement initialed and signed by Respondent on October 7, 2024.

I have reviewed the Motion and Voluntary Surrender Agreement. Respondent acknowledges in the Voluntary Surrender Agreement that the surrender is being made voluntarily in preference to appearing at a hearing; that Respondent is permanently relinquishing all rights to the credential; and that Respondent waives the right to a hearing, appeal, and judicial review. I find the Voluntary Surrender Agreement complies with the requirements of 46 C.F.R. § 5.203, and accordingly, I **GRANT** the Motion.¹
