## **ADMISSION ORDER**

On July 10, 2024, the United States Coast Guard Sector Sector Honolulu issued a Complaint against Respondent, MINA BRYSON, alleging they violated 46 U.S.C. § 7703(1)(B). The Coast Guard proposes a sanction of 4 months outright suspension of Respondent's Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC).

In Respondent's Answer, dated July 12, 2024, they admit to all the jurisdictional and factual allegations, and agrees with the Coast Guard's proposed sanction.

**WHEREFORE**, Upon consideration of the record, I hereby **ORDER** that the allegations in the Complaint are **PROVED BY THE ANSWER**. I have carefully reviewed the Complaint and Answer and find that the proposed sanction is appropriate under the provisions of 46 C.F.R. § 5.569.

**ORDER**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent's Coast Guard issued Merchant Mariner Credentials are Suspended Outright for four (4) Months, commencing on the date Respondent's credentials are deposited with the USCG Sector Honolulu. Respondent shall immediately deposit, by mail or in person, her Merchant Mariner Credential and any other Coast Guard issued credentials to: USCG Sector Honolulu 433 Ala Moana Blvd. Pier 4, Honolulu, HI 96813. Further, Respondent shall immediately cease using all Coast Guard issued credentials, including his Merchant Mariner Credential.
