ADMISSION ORDER

On February 26, 2024, the United States Coast Guard (Coast Guard) issued a Complaint

against Thomas E. Snyder (Respondent) alleging Respondent was convicted on February 1, 2024

of violating Alaska Statute 28.35.030(a)(2) Driving Under the Influence Alcohol or Drugs while

being a holder of a Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC).

The Coast Guard's complaint further alleges Respondent's violation of Alaska Statute

28.35.030(a)(2) is comparable to 49 U.S.C. § 30304(a)(3)(A), as identified by 46 U.S.C. §

7703(3). The Coast Guard proposes a sanction of three (3) months outright suspension of

Respondent's MMC.

In Respondent's Answer, dated February 26, 2024, Respondent admits to all

jurisdictional and factual allegations, and agrees with the proposed sanction.

WHEREFORE,

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, Respondent's conviction under 46 U.S.C. § 7703(3) is

PROVED BY ANSWER. I have carefully reviewed the file and find that the proposed sanction

is appropriate under the provisions of 46 C.F.R. § 5.569.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, Respondent's Merchant Mariner Credential is

SUSPENDED OUTRIGHT FOR THREE (3) MONTHS, commencing the date it was

deposited with the Coast Guard.
