ORDER GRANTING COAST GUARD’S MOTION FOR WITHDRAWAL

This matter comes before me on the United States Coast Guard’s (Coast Guard) Motion for Withdrawal. In its Motion the Coast Guard requests I dismiss this matter without prejudice because Respondent voluntarily surrendered his Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC). See 33 C.F.R. § 20.311. For the reasons set forth below, I **GRANT in Part** the Coast Guard’s Motion.

The Coast Guard initiated this administrative proceeding seeking to revoke Rafael Soto’s (Respondent) MMC for committing sexual assault. See 46 U.S.C. § 7704a(b). On April 4, 2024, Respondent filed an answer to the Complaint admitting to all jurisdictional and factual allegations. Thereafter, Respondent completed a Voluntary Surrender Agreement on April 16, 2024, which the Coast Guard attached to its August 20, 2024 Motion for Withdraw.

Pursuant to 33 C.F.R. § 20.311(c), an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) must approve the withdrawal of a case prior to its removal from the docket. Furthermore, the dismissal of a case “resides within the discretion of the ALJ.” 33 C.F.R. § 20.311(e). Upon consideration of the record, I hereby **GRANT IN PART** the Coast Guard’s Motion for Withdrawal and **DISMISS** this case **WITH PREJUDICE**.

WHEREFORE, this administrative proceeding is **WITHDRAWN** from the Administrative Law Judge docket.
