ORDER GRANTING JOINT STIPULATION FOR WITHDRAWAL

On July 18, 2024, the United States Coast Guard (Coast Guard) filed a Joint Stipulation for Withdrawal (Withdrawal) signed by the parties requesting withdrawal of the proceeding from the Administrative Law Judge Docket, and dismissal with prejudice in accordance with 33 C.F.R. §§ 20.311(a)(1), (b).
