**CONSENT ORDER**

On March 21, 2025, the Coast Guard filed a Complaint against Kevin Jay Snowden (Respondent), seeking revocation of his Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC). On May 27, 2025, the Coast Guard filed a Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order (Motion), containing the signed Settlement Agreement, to be approved as a settlement of this case under 33 C.F.R. § 20.502. As evidenced by their respective signatures, the parties assert that settlement is in the public interest and appropriate based on Respondent's willingness to undertake appropriate remedial action. The parties have waived a hearing in this matter, thus I have not conducted a hearing on the merits in this case. Having reviewed the agreement, I find the Settlement Agreement is fair, clear, and complies with the requirements of 33 C.F.R. § 20.502.

**ORDER**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, the Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order is **GRANTED**, and the Settlement Agreement is **APPROVED** in full and incorporated herein by reference. This Consent Order shall constitute full, final, and complete adjudication of this proceeding.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, the hearing scheduled to begin on August 26, 2025, in Norfolk, Virginia, is **CANCELED**.
