CONSENT ORDER

On March 20, 2025, the Coast Guard filed a Complaint against Tomas Alejandro Clarkson (Respondent), seeking revocation of his Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC). On June 17, 2025, the Coast Guard filed a Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order (Motion), containing the signed Settlement Agreement, to be approved as a settlement of this case under 33 C.F.R. § 20.502. As evidenced by their respective signatures, the parties assert that settlement is in the public interest and appropriate based on Respondent's willingness to undertake appropriate remedial action. The parties have waived a hearing in this matter, thus I have not conducted a hearing on the merits in this case nor received any evidence with regard to the allegations. Having reviewed the agreement, I find the Settlement Agreement is fair, clear, and complies with the requirements of 33 C.F.R. § 20.502.

WHEREFORE,

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order is **GRANTED**, and the Settlement Agreement is **APPROVED** in full and incorporated herein by reference. This Consent Order shall constitute full, final, and complete adjudication of this proceeding.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, the hearing scheduled to begin on July 24, 2025, in Baltimore, Maryland, is **CANCELED**.
