**CONSENT ORDER**

On August 21, 2025, the Coast Guard filed a Complaint against Shaylen Lewis (Respondent), seeking suspension of Respondent's Merchant Mariner Credential. On September 8, 2025, the Coast Guard filed a Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order (Motion), containing the signed Settlement Agreement, to be approved as a settlement of this case under 33 C.F.R. § 20.502. As evidenced by their respective signatures, the parties assert that settlement is in the public interest and appropriate based on Respondent's willingness to undertake appropriate remedial action. The parties have waived a hearing in this matter, thus I have not conducted a hearing on the merits in this case nor received any evidence with regard to the allegations. Having reviewed the agreement, I find the Settlement Agreement is fair, clear, and complies with the requirements of 33 C.F.R. § 20.502.
