## NATIONAL MARINE FISHERIES SERVICE'S NOTICE UPDATING THE COURT AND THE PARTIES ON THE STATUS OF THE INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT SECURING COAST GUARD ALJ SERVICES

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) and the United States Coast Guard

(Coast Guard) have entered an Interagency Agreement whereby NMFS has secured Coast Guard

Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) services for the above-captioned matter. The Agreement

currently expires on September 30, 2019. See Stone Decl. ¶ 2 and Exhibit 1 to Stone Decl.

Absent a modification extending the end date, the allocated funds will no longer be available for

use past September 30, 2019. Id.

Given the temporal proximity of the current hearing schedule for the above matter to the end date of the Agreement, the potential the ALJ may need additional time to draft his recommended decision and the parties potential need to file post-hearing briefs, and the potential for schedule changes, NMFS has undertaken an evaluation of the feasibility of extending its Interagency Agreement. *See* Stone Decl. ¶ 3. NMFS has determined that any extension would need to be in place prior to the expiration of the current agreement. *Id.* ¶ 4. NMFS has therefore

funds will continue to be available past September 30, 2019. Id. ¶ 5.
