IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that service of this Order Of Sanction on the parties and/or the parties' representative(s) serves as notice of appeal rights set for in 33 C.F.R. §§ 20.1001-20.1004. The thirty (30) time period within which to file the Notice of Appeal shall commence upon service of this Order of Sanction.
