**CONSENT ORDER APPROVING SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

On March 23, 2023, the Coast Guard filed a Complaint against Omiles Samuel Johnson (Respondent), alleging of misconduct in violation of 46 U.S.C. § 7703(1)(B) and 46 C.F.R. § 5.27. The Coast Guard alleges that Respondent failed to remain at his urine collection site for a Random drug test pursuant to 46 C.F.R. Part 16, which is a refusal to take a required drug test pursuant to 46 C.F.R. Part 16, as described by 49 C.F.R. § 40.191(a)(2).

On March 23, 2023, the parties in this case submitted a Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order to be approved as a settlement of the case under 33 C.F.R. § 20.502.

After carefully reviewing the terms of the Settlement Agreement, I find that it is fair, reasonable, and in substantial compliance with the requirements of 33 C.F.R. § 20.502.

**ORDER**

Upon consideration of the record, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Settlement Agreement is **APPROVED** in full and incorporated herein by reference.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Respondent's Merchant Mariner Credential is **REVOKED**. However, the revocation is stayed until **June 23, 2024**, to permit Respondent to complete a rehabilitation program and prove cure in accordance with the Settlement Agreement.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Respondent complete the terms of the Settlement Agreement prior to the termination of the stay. If Respondent satisfies the requirements, this order will reflect an outright suspension for the period of deposit to permit Respondent to complete and prove cure in accordance with the stipulated order contained in the Settlement Agreement.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this Consent Order shall constitute full, final, and complete adjudication of this proceeding.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**
