Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC) for drug use in violation of 46 U.S.C. § 7704(b) and 46

C.F.R. § 5.35. Specifically, the Coast Guard alleges Respondent took a periodic drug test

pursuant to 46 C.F.R. Part 16 on February 24, 2023, in which his specimen tested positive for

cocaine metabolites.

Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order to be approved as a settlement of the case

under 33 C.F.R. § 20.502.
