CONSENT ORDER AND ORDER GRANTING

The Coast Guard filed a Motion for Default Order on May 24, 2024. In its Motion for Default, the Coast Guard alleges Anaudia Pressley (Respondent) failed to answer the Complaint filed March 5, 2024. However, on June 12, 2024, the parties entered into a Settlement Agreement and filed a Motion for Approval of Settlement Agreement and Entry of Consent Order under 33 C.F.R. § 20.502.
