**ADMISSION ORDER**

On January 31, 2025, the United States Coast Guard Marine Safety Unit Savannah issued a Complaint against Respondent, JACOB LOMOTEY, alleging they violated 46 U.S.C. § 7703(1)(a). The Coast Guard proposes a sanction of one (3) months outright suspension of Respondent’s Merchant Mariner Credential (MMC).

In Respondent’s Answer, dated February 4, 2025, they admit to all the jurisdictional and factual allegations, and agrees with the Coast Guard’s proposed sanction.

**WHEREFORE**, Upon consideration of the record, I hereby **ORDER** that the allegations in the Complaint are **PROVED BY THE ANSWER**. I have carefully reviewed the Complaint and Answer and find that the proposed sanction is appropriate under the provisions of 46 C.F.R. § 5.569.

**ORDER**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondent's Coast Guard issued Merchant Mariner Credentials are Suspended Outright for one (3) Months, commencing on the date Respondent's credentials are deposited with the USCG Marine Safety Unit Savannah. Respondent shall immediately deposit, by mail or in person, his Merchant Mariner Credential and any other Coast Guard issued credentials to: USCG Marine Safety Unit Savannah, 100 W. Oglethorpe Ave. Suite 1017, Savannah, GA 31401. Further, Respondent shall immediately cease using all Coast Guard issued credentials, including his Merchant Mariner Credential.
