Rules of Practice, Procedure, and Evidence for Administrative Proceedings of the Coast Guard

§ 20.608 Subpoenas. (a) Any party may request the ALJ to issue a subpoena for the attendance of a person, the giving of testimony, or the production of books, papers, documents, or any other relevant evidence during discovery or for any hearing. Any party seeking a subpoena from the ALJ shall request its issuance by motion. (b) An ALJ may, for good cause shown, apply to the United States District Court for the issuance of an order compelling the appearance and testimony of a witness or the production of evidence. (c) A person serving a subpoena shall prepare a written statement setting forth either the date, time, and manner of service or the reason for failure of service. He or she shall swear to or affirm the statement, attach it to a copy of the subpoena

§ 20.609 Motions to quash or modify. (a) A person to whom a subpoena is directed may, by motion with notice to the party requesting the subpoena, ask the ALJ to guash or modify the subpoena. (b) Except when made at a hearing, the motion must be filed (1) 10 days or less after service of a subpoena compelling the appearance and testimony of a witness or the production of evidence or (2) at or before the time specified in the subpoena for compliance, whichever is earlier. (c) If the subpoena is served at a hearing, the person to whom it is directed may, in person at the hearing or in writing within a reasonable time fixed by the ALJ, ask the ALJ to guash or modify it. (d) The ALJ may guash or modify the subpoena if it is unreasonable or requires evidence not relevant to any matter in issue.
