- To be represented at trial by a military attorney, free of charge, including a military attorney of my own selection, if that attorney is reasonably available. In addition to a military attorney, I may have a civilian attorney at my own expense
- To be tried by a court-martial composed of at least three officers as members or, at my
  request, at least one-third of the court members would be enlisted personnel. If tried by a
  court-martial with members, two-thirds of the members, voting by secret ballot, would have
  to agree in any finding of guilty, and two-thirds of the members would also have to agree on
  any sentence to be imposed, should I be found guilty; and
- To request trial by military judge alone. If tried by military judge alone, the military judge alone would determine my guilt or innocence and, if I were found guilty, he alone would

determine the sentence imposed.
