

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RIGHTS-ACCEPTANCE OF SCM

I _____ attached to _____ acknowledge the following facts and rights regarding summary court-martial.

_____ I have the right to refuse trial by summary court-martial.

_____ I have the right to consult with an attorney prior to deciding whether to accept or refuse trial by summary court-martial. Should I desire to consult with an attorney, I understand that a military attorney will be made available to advise me, free of charge, or I may consult with a civilian attorney at my own expense. I do not have the right to be represented by a military attorney at summary court-martial.

_____ If I **accept** trial by summary court-martial, I have the following rights:

- To be represented at trial by a civilian attorney provided by me at my own expense, or to be assisted by a non-attorney representative;
- To remain silent, and to plead not guilty, thus placing upon the government the burden of proving my guilt beyond a reasonable doubt;
- To have the summary court-martial call, or subpoena, witnesses to testify on my behalf;
- To confront and cross examine all witnesses against me; and
- If found guilty, to present matters which may mitigate the offense or demonstrate extenuating circumstances as to why I committed the offense(s).

_____ I understand that the maximum punishment that may be adjudged by a summary court-martial is:

E-4 and below	E-5 and above

_____ Should I **refuse** trial by summary court-martial, my commanding officer may refer the charge(s) to trial by special court-martial or general court-martial. At a special court-martial, in addition to those rights set forth in paragraph 3, I would have the following rights:

- To be represented at trial by a military attorney, free of charge, including a military attorney of my own selection, if that attorney is reasonably available. In addition to a military attorney, I may have a civilian attorney at my own expense
- To be tried by a court-martial composed of at least four officers as members or, at my request, at least one-third of the court members would be enlisted personnel. If tried by a court-martial with members, three-fourths of the members, voting by secret ballot, would have to agree in any finding of guilty, and three-fourths of the members would also have to agree on any sentence to be imposed, should I be found guilty; and
- To request trial by military judge alone. If tried by military judge alone, the military judge alone would determine my guilt or innocence and, if I were found guilty, he alone would

determine the sentence imposed.
