Application Deadlines

Semi-annual application cycles: apply in August or February of your 2L year.

Eligibility

- Age: 21-39
- Education: 2L at an ABA-accredited law school
- Citizenship: U.S. citizen
- Medical: Must meet medical and physical accession standards
- Eligible for security clearance

- Commission as a lieutenant (O-3)
