Initial Contact and Eligibility:

Apply to MARAD for MSF/CSF/TSF or VISA/program enrollment (N/A for vessels re-flagging into RRF)

Application for Inspection:

Prepare <u>CG-3752</u> for submission to <u>cognizant OCMI</u> and <u>Traveling Inspection Staff</u>

Submit Plans and Information w/30 days of reflag inspection

Prepare for Initial Inspection

Conduct Initial Inspection

Note 1 – Exemptions/Equivalents, Vessel Security Plan, <u>Vessel Response Plan</u> including SOPEP/SMPEP (as applicable) must be submitted to the Coast Guard for approval.

Note 2 – Periodic Safety Test Procedures (PSTPs) submit to <u>USCG</u> or ACS. (Authorized Classification Society).

Note 3 – Apply to <u>NVDC</u> for registry documentation

Note 4 – Apply for Continuous Synopsis Record (CSR) from the USCG <u>CSR Desk</u>.

Note 5 - Apply to EPA for EIAPP Certs

Note 6 - Apply to FCC for Ship Station License

Identify ACS Surveyor Responsible for re-flag

Provide previous survey details and drydocking report

Prepare "Gap Analysis"
