Enclosed is the Coast Guard Bridge Permit 2-13-13 dated September 27, 2013, approving the location and plans for a replacement bridge across the Columbia River, at mile 106.4, between Portland, Oregon and Vancouver, Washington.

Additional provisions and conditions for the proposed construction and demolition work will be provided by the Thirteenth Coast Guard District Bridge Administrator under separate correspondence. These provisions will include requirements to submit a contractors plan, schedule and sequence of operations; temporarily mark any obstructions placed in the water; keep the local Coast Guard Marine Safety Unit informed of any bridge construction or demolition activity that will affect waterway users; install permanent navigational lights; and various other reporting and documentation requirements.
