Operation Order

CCGDTHREE No. 04-84

Time Zone: Use local time for operations.

Task Organization:

- a. Commander, Third Coast Guard District
- b. Commander, Coast Guard Group, New York, NY
- c. Commanding Officer, USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY (WTGB 107)
- d. Commanding Officer, USCG Support Center, New York, NY

1. SITUATION. USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY (WTGB 107) will arrive in the Third District for permanent homeport assignment at Governors Island, NY in late December 1984. PENOBSCOT BAY will be placed in "In Commission, Active" status in Norfolk, VA. A formal commissioning ceremony will be held after arrival at Governors Island, NY at which time PENOBSCOT BAY will become a subordinate unit of Commander, Coast Guard Group, New York, NY.

2. MISSION. Accept and commission USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY (WTGB 107).

3. EXECUTION. This force will accept and commission USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY. Specific tasking is as follows:

a. CCGDTHREE:

(1) Assume ADCON when PENOBSCOT BAY is placed in "Inactive, Pending Placement In Commission" status. (o)

(2) Assume OPCON upon PENOBSCOT BAY arrival in Third Coast Guard District. (o)

(3) Provide PENOBSCOT BAY with full allowance of District publications and directives and amend the CCGD3 Publications and Directives Index to include PENOBSCOT BAY. (m/dcs-1)

(4) Provide PENOBSCOT BAY with a copy of the CCGD3 Standing Operating Procedures and ensure that the SOP is amended to reflect the addition of PENOBSCOT BAY to CCGD3. (or)

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3. a. (5) Issue necessary classified materials. (dtm)
- (6) Provide telephone services at Governors Island, NY and include telephone number in CCGD3 Telephone Directory. (dtm)
- (7) Issue appropriate press releases. (dpa)
- (8) Act as District Project Officer and coordinate appropriate ceremonies to recognize formal commissioning of PENOBSCOT BAY in New York. (dpa)
- (9) Coordinate with CO, Support Center, New York preparation of mooring facilities at Governors Island for PENOBSCOT BAY. (ecv)
- (10) Establish contract for fuel oil for PENOBSCOT BAY at Governors Island. (flp)
- (11) Establish a Coast Guard Dining Facility aboard PENOBSCOT BAY upon commissioning; coordinate with CCGDFIVE for SAT assistance. (fbr)
- (12) Establish Morale Fund aboard PENOBSCOT BAY. (ps)
- b. Commander, Coast Guard Group New York:
- (1) Coordinate with CCGDTHREE (ecv) and SUPRTCEN New York concerning facilities for PENOBSCOT BAY.
- (2) Assist CCGDTHREE (dpa) in preparing for commissioning ceremony.
- (3) Assume ADCON and OPCON of PENOBSCOT BAY when directed.
- c. Commanding Officer, USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY shall:
- (1) Upon arrival in Third District CHOP to CCGDTHREE and proceed to Governors Island, NY.
- (2) Submit Quarterly Abstract of Operations (Boats and Cutters) per COMDTINST 3123.7 (series).
- (3) Comply with the operational reporting requirements of reference (c).
- d. Commanding Officer, USCG Support Center, New York shall provide mooring and other facilities for PENOBSCOT BAY.

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4. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS. As specified in Paragraph 3, Execution.

5. COMMAND AND SIGNAL.

a. CCGDTHREE will assume administrative control (ADCON) of PENOBSCOT BAY when placed in "Inactive, Pending placement in Commission" status and operational control (OPCON) upon arrival in the Third District.

b. Commander, Group New York NY will assume administrative and operational control when directed by CCGDTHREE.

c. Normal communications procedures apply.
