

# REPORTING INFORMATION

**LOCATION OF NEAREST EXCHANGE AND COMMISSARY:** Small CG Exchange on base, Naval Station Everett Exchange & Commissary – 38 mi. North of Sector Puget Sound, and McChord AFB – 41 mi. South of Sector Puget Sound.

**WHAT TYPE OF CONTINUING EDUCATION IS AVAILABLE IN THE AREA:** Various community colleges and universities in town as well as classes offered on base. SAT and ACET tests are available through the unit ESO.

**WHAT TYPE OF TRANSPORTATION IS AVAILABLE:** Public Transportation is available and annual Mass Transit Passes for ferries, buses and trains are available at no charge through the ORCA Pass which can be obtained on base. Carpools/Metro Van Pools are also available which is highly recommended for consideration as parking on base is extremely limited.
