- ALBACORE is located at Station Little Creek which is on the Joint Expeditionary Base, Little Creek-Fort Story.
- There are several different Gates you can enter in from on the base. Here are directions from Gate 3 which is located at the intersection of Shore Dr. and Helicopter Rd:
- After entering Gate 3 turn left at the first light onto Amphibious Dr.
- Then turn right at the first stop sign on Abbott Rd
- Continue down that road until it ends and on the left you will see the entrance to Station Little Creek
- Turn left into the station
- The cutter is located back behind the station at the pier
