

U.S. Coast Guard Aids to Navigation Team Chincoteague

Chincoteague Island is located on the Eastern Shore of Virginia and is the homeport for Aids to Navigation Team (ANT) Chincoteague. The ANT is co-located with Station Chincoteague at Sector Field Office Eastern Shore, Virginia.

ANT Chincoteague's area of responsibility begins at Isle of Wight Bay in Ocean City, Maryland and runs south to the entrance to the Chesapeake Bay along the Atlantic Ocean. The border then turns north and continues along Virginia's Eastern Shore to Nandua Creek, encompassing approximately 114 miles of coastline.

The unit is billeted for 8 people:

BMC as Officer in Charge;

BM1 as Executive Petty Officer;

MK1 as Engineering Petty Officer;

A crew of one BM2, one MK3, two Seaman and one Fireman.

ANT Chincoteague utilizes the following vessels to service our Aids to Navigation:

63-foot Aid to Navigation Boat (ANB)

21-foot "Trailerable" Aid to Navigation Boat (TANB)

18-foot Work Boat
