



MWR Pool Rules

1. Photo I.D. required. Patrons **MUST** sign in **UPON** entrance to the facility. Members **MUST** show tags upon entrance.
2. All Patrons using the pool are required to shower **BEFORE** entering the pool, **NO** EXEPTIONS.
3. No one with obvious evidence of a cold or other communicable disease, sores or lesions may enter the pool.
4. Children under 2 years of age must wear “leak-proof” diapers. Disposable diapers are not allowed. The spirit of this rule intends to ensure sanitary conditions at all times. If your child “LEAKS”, the pool will be closed for super-chlorination.
5. Children under the age of 10 have to be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older. Children 10 or older must be able to swim continuously for 25 meters in order to come to the pool alone, if they have written permission from their parents and the pool manager.
6. Lifeguards are responsible for the safety of *EVERY* patron. Please be ATTENTIVE to your child.
7. Proper swim attire is required. Clean T-shirts are permitted.
8. Long hair must be pulled back or bathing cap must be used.
9. Objects to be used in the pool such as floating aids and snorkeling gear, etc. are allowed on a **NOT TO INTERFERE BASIS**. The lifeguard will make the final determination on items permitted. All items will be washed before introducing them into the pool.
10. Non-swimmers who wear flotation devices may not be in water over their head. Lifeguards may administer a swim test to patrons that may want to cross into deeper water.
11. Scuba Equipment is only allowed with prior permission of the pool manager.
12. **HORSEPLAY** is not permitted. This includes but not limited to: **RUNNING, FIGHTING, TOWEL POPPING, DUNKING AND EXCESIVE SPLASHING.**
13. Lifeguard equipment is only for use in an emergency or for training.
14. **ONLY ONE PERSON IS PERMITTED ON THE SLIDE AT A TIME. THOSE USING THE SLIDE MUST BE SITTING UP, FACING FORWARD, AND WATCHING OUT FOR OTHER PATRONS WHO ARE SWIMMING IN THE POOL.**
15. No drinking or eating of any kind within 12 feet of the pool. This includes chewing gum.
16. Smoking is not allowed inside the facility. Smokers are to leave facility and smoke outside 50 ft away from any entrance to facility.

17. No GLASS containers are allowed inside the facility at all times.
18. The uses of profane language or gestures are prohibited.
19. Patrons who are intoxicated must leave the pool area. They will be asked to leave the pool area for their sake and safety of others. Security may be notified of situation.
20. Practice of hyperventilation and extended breath holding is prohibited.
21. A 10-15 minute breaks will be called every two hours. Or at lifeguard's discretion when day is causing fatigue (eg: heat advisory day). Any 18 or older patrons may stain in the pool. All those who have passed the American Red Cross Level 6 course are permitted to swim during the breaks.
22. MWR employees are not responsible for los property or items this includes items left inside your vehicles.
23. No OUTSIDE RADIOS ARE PERMITTED this excludes personal players with headphones.(IPODs,MP3 players).\
24. During inclement weather, the pool will be cleared if rainfall prevents visibility of pool bottom, or if lightning strikes within a 5 mile radius of the facility. A period of 20 minutes will pass from time of last lighting strike before pool is re-opened.
25. The lifeguard or pool manager may temporarily suspend the swimming privileges of any individual for violation of pool rules. Repeat offenders may be barred from further use of the pool.
26. THE DUTY LIFEGUARD HAS THE AUTHORITY TO IMPLEMENT ADDITIONAL RULES AS NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN ORDER AND SAFETY. THE LIFEGUARDS DECISION IS **FINAL**
